## Extra Curricular Activities

## House System

Sensitivity and creativity are its out come in various forms and shades, be it science, literature, art, music or theatre. With such rich experience what emerges is a vibrant/ radiating personality with a meaningful purpose and a positive out look.



To achieve this goal in mind and to execute this ideal in daily routine of the students, "House System" has been introduced. The whole school is divided into four Houses namely **Knowledge, Truth, Success, Happiness**. By turns every House shoulders various levels of duties involved during their term. These include conduct of school prayer and assembly, reading of news, celebration of festivals and functions, preparation of House Boards and management of over all discipline of the students.

Beside this, there are various activities carried on at class level as well as Inter House level. These include Calligraphy, Story Telling, Collage Making, Preparing Things from Waste, Clay modelling, Flower arrangement etc.
